

## Dear Arean,

This email intends to inform you of UNLV's process for distributing Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) in the spring 2022 semester. This week, the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships will complete the eligibility review for those students who submitted a FAFSA or Alternate Need Form for 2021-2022. Next week, on February 15, 2022, the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships will send financial aid notifications to those who qualify for a distribution of HEERF funds.

In preparation for those distributions, we wanted to send a reminder to sign up for or update your direct deposit information and ensure your mailing address in your <u>MyUNLV</u> account is current. No further action by you is required at this time.

Based on the initial review of the information on file, just over 21,400 students are eligible for consideration to receive HEERF funding this semester. Those who receive notice of the funding on February 15, 2022, will need to <u>log into MyUNLV</u> and review the 2021-2022 financial aid year to see the amount and complete the assigned task to receive the funds.

Once funds are applied, students may use them to offset COVID-19 financial impacts. This can include tuition, housing, books, supplies, and fees, among other costs related to COVID-19. Students will have the option to receive a refund or apply funds directly to a balance at UNLV.

We will continue to keep you posted.
