

# Christopher P. Cain

## Brief Biography

Cain, honored to be one of 375 PGA Master Professionals since 1969, has been a member of the PGA of Management Programs (M.S. '04), he served the club and golf industry for 11 years in public, resort, and private settings with management experience in assistant, teaching, and head professional positions. Cain's graduate studies included work with Penn St Kinesiology, Turfgrass Management, and Exercise and Sports Science. Cain's thesis explored the relationship between voluntary golfer practice types and performance.

Cain moved from the Philadelphia Section PGA to the Southwest Section PGA in 2004 to reestablish regional, and national levels. Cain's service with the Southern Nevada Chapter in 2005 evolved to Past President in 2013. For two terms he served the Southwest Section Board of Directors, and chaired Cain as 2014. Cain also served terms as an appointed member of the Board of Directors for allied associations including: The First Tee of Southern Nevada (junior body); the Southern Nevada Golf Association (amateur body); the National Advisory Board to Reed Exhibitions (development strategies for the PGA Show and Fall Expo); and currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Nevada PGA
