Course

Department and program requirements cannot be waived. World language/culture is not waived with associate degree. Remember to send final transcripts with degree noted.

Program Specific Information: Students who choose Option A must complete two areas of study with a minimum of 18 credits in each. A minimum of 15 credits in each area of study must be selected from upper-division courses.

Students who choose Option B must complete three areas of study with a minimum of 12 credits in each. A minimum of 9 credits in each area of study must be selected from upper-division courses.

Some courses that fulfill specific general education requirements at CSN may fulfill different general education requirements at UNLV. Please see a UNLV/CSN Transfer Program Advisor to confirm your choices.

Students must obtain a C or better in all IDS courses.

World Language or Culture (6-8 Credits): Any world language 111+; ANTH206; ENG231, ENG232, ENG292; HIST105, HIST106, HIST150, HIST151, HIST208, HIST209, HIST227, HIST228; PHIL124, PHIL210; PSC211, PSC231. The two courses must be in the same world language (cannot use computer language or American Sign Language) or two courses in world culture.

Transfer Policies:

REVISED 50/50 RULE

The policy stating that UNLV will only accept up to 60 credits to be transferred and applied to any specific program/major is no longer in place. Unless a college/major has a specific requirement on credit limitations i.e., Lee Business School, College of Education, transfer credits from 2-year instituti
