

Library To-Do List For Graduate Students

Learn the name of your liaison librarian: library.unlv.edu/contact/librarians_by_subject

Liaison librarians have subject-specific expertise and can assist you with locating resources related to your research area. If you are teaching, a liaison librarian can work to provide library instruction for your students.

Make an appointment with your liaison librarian: guides.library.unlv.edu/appointments

Activate your library account: library.unlv.edu/help/activating_your_account

Access electronic resources off campus, borrow books we do not own, and renew books online.

Get an account with RefWorks, a web-based bibliographic management tool: library.unlv.edu/research/refworks

Start organizing your research right away.

Install RefWorks Write-N-Cite on your personal computer: library.unlv.edu/help/refworks/writencite.html

Access your RefWorks references and easily cite and format them within Microsoft Word. It does the work for you.

Sign up for an ILLiad account: unlv.illiad.oclc.org/illiad/logon.html

Request items we do not own from other libraries. You can get scanned articles emailed to you within three days and books within seven days.
